

PROVISIONS RELATING TO ACCREDIA ACCREDITATION

A. Information regarding ACCREDIA Accreditation for Testing Laboratories

1. The Laboratory T.R.I. informed of the existence of the covenant with ACCREDIA. Any user has the right to examine the covenant, including the requirements contained in the ACCREDIA documents.
2. ACCREDIA verify and insure on the Laboratory compliance with the requirements for the accreditation, allowing the laboratory to cite this compliance, to the extent permitted by applicable documents of ACCREDIA, in the test reports relating to accredited tests and in own documentation.
3. The Laboratory T.R.I. takes the utmost willingness to provide collaboration to customers. This collaboration is essential to clarify the methods for testing and measurement on the basis of the characteristics of a product and never has the character of advice: it is aimed at clarifying to the customer the statements of the rule that, in particular, may have lead to the entry of non-compliance.
4. Cooperation with customers is also expressed through the willingness to allow to the same the access to laboratories to assist in tests / measurements on their products, while preserving the anonymity of competing products.
5. The laboratory keep the samples on which he performed the test, for the time agreed with the applicant. In case this agreement is missing, on the test report is declared the time of the conservation at the Laboratory of the sample on which the test was performed.
6. The Laboratory is allowed to use the Brand or to include the reference to the accreditation in the documents issued.
7. In accordance with Regulation RG -09 it is stated:
 - The Brand and any reference to accreditation shall not be applied on a test sample, or a product, or part of it, or used to let understood the product certification.
 - The Brand or the reference to the accreditation should not be used in the documentation concerning a product, unless a copy of the test report is reported.
 - The Brand and any reference to the accreditation should not be used in such a way as to create the impression that ACCREDIA accept responsibility for the result of the test, or for any opinion or interpretation that might arise, or that ACCREDIA give his approval to a test sample or to a product.
7. The timing of preservation of records of tests carried out, in line with the rules of TRI, are equal to ten (10) years. Only in the case of written requests of variations of this terms from the client, these will be included in the relative commercial offer.

B. Information regarding ACCREDIA Accreditation for Product Certification

As a Conformity Assessment Body, T.R.I. may be accredited by the Italian National Accreditation Body ("ACCREDIA").

With specific reference to product certification, the accreditation status of T.R.I. for the relevant schemes and sectors may be verified at any time by consulting the websites www.tuv.com/italy and www.accredia.it, or by direct request to T.R.I.

Where applicable, T.R.I. shall inform the Applicant Organization or the holder of the certification of any suspension, withdrawal or revocation of its accreditation for the relevant scheme and shall, where appropriate, support the transition to another accredited body.

T.R.I. shall not be liable in any way for any damages suffered by the Organization as a result of suspension, withdrawal or revocation of accreditation. In such cases, the Organization shall be entitled to withdraw from the certification without notice and without additional charges.
